



Dear Parents and Carers,

Lent is an important time in the Catholic faith where we look forward to the arrival of Easter. During Lent, we try to support those in need. As part of this, we are going to do 'Fundraising Friday'. Every Friday in Lent we will raise money for The Good Shepherd Appeal, which goes towards helping families in need. Please see the list below of our planned events to look forward to after the half term:

• Friday 23rd February - Bend the Rules day

On this day only, your child can choose to bend one or more of the rules below. There is a 50p charge for every rule your child chooses to break and the money should be brought into school on Friday 23rd February in a named, sealed envelope. The school council have devised a set of rule breaks below:

Wear a non-uniform top to school
Bring a teddy bear to school
Wear nail varnish or a temporary tattoo at school
Wear your pyjamas/ onesie to school
Wear a hat in class for the whole day
Eat your pudding before your main course

• Friday 1st March - Luxury hamper

On this day, please bring a luxury item into school that could form part of a luxury class hamper. This could be a bottle of wine brought to the office by an adult, a box of chocolates or a packet of biscuits as examples. Each class will create a luxury item hamper with the items that have been donated. On Friday $1^{\rm st}$ March and any day during the week after, your child is able to bring 20p to purchase a single raffle ticket or £1 for a strip to enter into the luxury hamper raffle. We will then draw the raffles in assembly on Friday $8^{\rm th}$ March.

• Friday 8th March - World Book Day - £1 suggested voluntary donation

• Friday 15th March - St Patrick's Day
